Future Publishing is Taking 60,000 Square Feet in Paddington

Communications and advertising giant WPP has let 60,000 square feet of offices at 121-141 Westbourne Terrace in Paddington to Future Publishing, the owner of comparisons websites GoCompare and Look After My Bills, and well-known magazine titles such as MacLife and Horse & Hound.

Mark Kleinman, the director of James Andrew International, who represented WPP, said the building had been recently refurbished to provide "bright, open plan office accommodation with the benefit of 4m floor to ceiling height".

Future Publishing entered into a 14-year term with a break option at the seventh year for the building which is owned by M&G Real Estate. It currently has offices at Praed Mews in Paddington.
