

WPP takes 205,000 sq ft of Dutch office's in Rivierstaete

Vastint Netherlands has concluded a lease with WPP for 205,000 sq ft of office space in the Rivierstaete building in Amsterdam.



This latest letting at the formerly white building along the Amstel river means the building is now two-thirds let. It is expected to be delivered to advertising and marketing services company WPP at the end of 2017 for their fit-out after renovations.

Rivierstaete will be a sustainable asset upon completion as Vastint aims for energy label A and a BREEAM Very Good certification. Upon its original completion in 1973 Rivierstaete was the largest office building in Europe.

Cees Gehrels, general manager of Vastint Netherlands said: "WPP, the largest communications services company in the world, is a fantastic lessee for Rivierstaete.

"WPP was also particularly attracted, just as we were at the time, to the magnificent transparent design by Roberto Meyer and the opportunity to create a high-quality working environment. We have every confidence that the remaining 10,000 m2 will be let in the very near future".
