



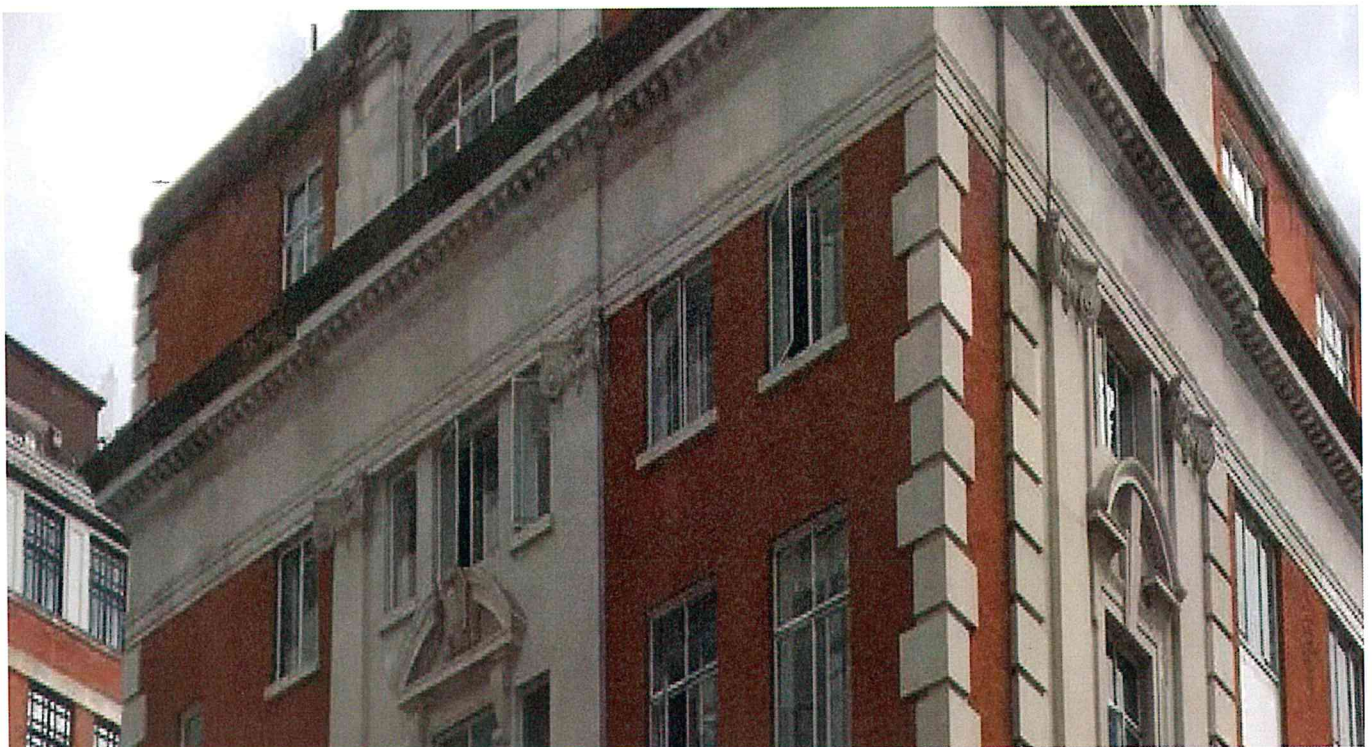

The Office Group is planning to refurbish Brock House in Fitzrovia

The Office Group on Tuesday agreed to convert a former BBC base and concert hall in Fitzrovia into space for start-ups.

The shared offices company has signed a 20-year lease with landlord Gascoyne Holdings for 28,000 square feet Brock House.

It opened in 1908 as the Philharmonic Hall and was later used as a cinema. Most recently it was occupied by the BBC.

Charlie Green, co-chief executive at The Office Group, said: “Brock House is one of those unique buildings in London that is a true island site, so you have natural light everywhere.”
